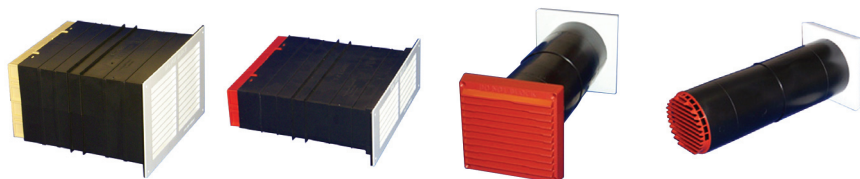

Noise pollution is becoming an increasing problem as transport systems develop and there are fewer Greenfield sites available for new-build housing.

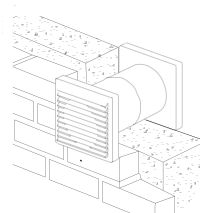


## THE NEED FOR VENTILATION

Ventilation is essential, and required by building regulations, but it can provide a path for noise to penetrate.

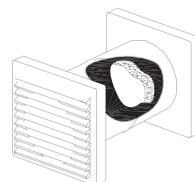
## NOISE LEVELS AND PLANNING
